






2. Select the two 10" logs and rest them on the left and right of the base log. These will create your main stack.



3. Select the 6" slim log and lay it across the main log diagonally.





4. Select two more of the 8" logs in your kit, and lay them under the 8" logs. The inside end of the log will be towards you and the outside end will be towards the flame screen.



5. This step may not be needed for 52" & 54" fireplaces. If you are happy with your layout continue to next step. For 56" and 60" select the last 8" logs, and lay these on top of the 8" logs previously stacked, crossing directions where possible.



6. Select the 10" slim log and lay it across the main log diagonally.



7. Use the bag of wood chips and place a few chips and chunks in the gaps between the logs. We recommend using these sparingly for the best appearance and to maximize the light output from the ember bed.





3. Select the 12" large logs, and stack these on the ends of the 16" logs.



4. Select the 12" slim logs and lay them under the 12" large logs. The inside end of the log may be towards you and the outside end may be towards the flame screen.



5. Select the two of the 8" slim logs, and lay them under the 16" large logs previously stacked, crossing directions where possible.



6. Select two more of the 8" slim logs in your kit, and lay these over the 12" slim logs.



7. Select a 8" slim log and lay it across the main log diagonally.



8. Select the 10" slim logs in your kit, and stack these laying over the 12" slim logs.




9. Use the bag of wood chips and place a few chips and chunks in the gaps between the logs. We recommend using these sparingly for the best appearance and to maximize the light output from the ember bed.

2. Select two of the 16" logs and rest them on the left and right of the first log. These are now creating the main portion of you stack. Spreading these out more for linear shaped fireplaces.





3. Select the 12" large logs, and stack these on the ends of the 16" logs.



4. Select the 12" slim logs and stack these on the ends of the 12" big logs.



5. Select the last two of the 16" logs, and rest them on the left and right of the 12" slim logs. The 16" logs should be resting on the ember bed. Note on 96"-100" units, these logs may need to brought in closer or not used.



Select the last two of the 12" large logs, and lay these near the 16" logs. The inside end of the log will be towards you and the outside end will be towards the flame screen. Note this step may not be needed on 96"-100" units.



7. Select 8" slim log and lay them under the 16" Side logs previously stacked, crossing directions where possible.



8. Select the 10" slim logs, and stack these laying under the 12" slim logs.



Select two 10" slim logs, and stack these laying over the 16" filler logs. The inside end of the log may be towards you and the outside end may be towards the flame screen. Note this step may not be needed on 96"-100" units.



10. Select the last two 10" slim logs, and stack these laying over the 12" large logs. The inside end of the log will face the flame screen and the outside end may be towards you. Note this step may not be needed on 96"-100" units.



11. Select 10" slim log and lay it across the main log diagonally.



12. Use the bag of wood chips and place a few chips and chunks in the gaps between the logs. We recommend using these sparingly for the best appearance and to maximize the light output from the ember bed.


